Akhtar, Rūznāmah-i (Istānbūl, Qajar) – Archive of 22 years, 893 issues

Akhtar, a Persian publication that was issued in Istanbul during the late Qajar period, was established with the support of the Iranian ambassador to the Ottoman Empire, Mīrzā Muḥsin Khān Mu'īn al-Mulk (later Muḥshīr al-Dawla), and with financial assistance from the Iranian government. The journal was managed by Muḥammad Ṭāhīr Tabrizī, while its editorial responsibilities were handled by Mīrzā Najaf 'Alī Khān Khū'ī, who served as both a translator and deputy at the Iranian embassy. The first issue of Akhtar was published on 16 Dhū al-Ḥijja 1292 Qamari (13 January 1876 CE, corresponding to 23 Dey 1254 Shamsī)...

Anjuman-i Tabrīz, Rūznāmah-i (Qājār) – Collection of 4 years 221 issues

Rūznāmah-i Anjuman-i Tabrīz” was managed by Sayyid ‘Alī Akbar Khān, and was published on a half-page in Ramadan 1324. It was initially founded under the title “Rūznāmah-i Majlis-i Millī-i Tabrīz”. This was the first newspaper printed in Tabriz after the declaration of constitutionalism. According to the statement of the late Tarbiyat in the list of newspapers of Azerbaijan, as the word “Majlis” was not appropriate, a replacement issue was printed and published with the title “Rūznāmah-i Millī...”

The magazine “Bahār”, published by Yūsuf l’tiṣāmī (l’tiṣām al-Mulk Āshtiyānī), is one of the most important and influential publications in the history of Iranian press. It was published in two periods and covered scientific, literary, ethical, historical, and artistic subjects. Most of the magazine’s content was written or translated by Yūsuf l’tiṣāmī, and a large portion was dedicated to Western culture. This magazine was known for its modern and European style and paid special attention to contemporary literature and literary criticism...

Chihrah'namā, Rūznāmah-i (Qāhirah) – Collection of 50 years, 570 issues

Chihrah'namā, a newspaper, was the oldest Persian-language political and social publication and one of the influential periodicals in shaping the thoughts and beliefs of Iranians. Initially published in Alexandria and later in Cairo, it was circulated from the late Qajar period until the mid-reign of the second Pahlavi monarch. The founder and director of Chihrah'numā was ‘Abd al-Muḥammad Īrānī, nicknamed Mu’addib al-Sulṭān, an Isfahani merchant and writer. He travelled from Isfahan to Baku and then migrated to Egypt, representing the Islamīyah Company, which was established by the initiative and support of the clerics of Isfahan to counteract British economic influence...

The newspaper Dānish was printed and published under the supervision of 'Alīqolī Mukhabir al-Dawlah, the then Minister of Sciences, starting from Tuesday, 23 Rajab 1299 AH. It was produced with the investment of the Ministry at the special scientific printing house located at the Dār al-Funūn School in Tehran. On both sides of the title of this publication, it was stated that the carriers of this newspaper in Tehran and elsewhere in other cities of Iran are not entitled to demand payment, and the announcement of this newspaper is free of charge. Additionally, it was mentioned under the title that the newspaper Dānish is printed twice a month and distributed free of charge. Anyone who sends news and information related to the sciences and

education to the Department of the Ministry of Sciences will have it published under their name.

Dānish was a Persian women's journal which was edited in Tehran. It was published weekly from 1910 until 1911 in 30 issues. Dānish was Iran's first journal for women. Political topics were not part of the content, but rather domestic issues in which the women were interested at that time. Articles on topics like education and parenting were published as well as chapters of serialised novels. The frequency of Dānish which was based in Tehran became irregular over time...

The "Rūznāmah-i Dawlat-i 'Aliyyah-i Īrān" is the first illustrated newspaper published in Iran, which began its circulation using lithographic printing from the year 1277 AH. This newspaper was essentially a modified version of the well-known "Vaḳāyī' Ittiḳāqīyah" and, after adding illustrations and making some changes, it was given a new title. The "Rūznāmah-i Dawlat-i 'Aliyyah-i Īrān," which began publication under issue number 472 on Thursday, 19 Šafar al-Muḏaffar 1277 AH in Dār al-Khilāfah Tehran, was the fourth name for the newspaper that had previously been published under the names "Rūznāmah-i Akhbār-i Dār al-Khilāfah Tehran," "Rūznāmah-i Vaḳāyī' Ittiḳāqīyah" and "Rūznāmah-i Vaḳāyī'," with a total of 471 issues published.

In the month of Rabi' al-Avval 1283 AH, during the tenure of I'tizād al-Saltānah as the Minister of Science, when Mīrzā Abū al-Ḥasan Khān Ṣanī' al-Dawlah was in charge of the printing house and government newspapers, Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh ordered the publication of four newspapers in Tihṙān. These were: first, a government newspaper without illustrations; second, an illustrated government newspaper; third, a national newspaper; and fourth, a scientific newspaper. "Rūznāmah-i Dawlatī", maintaining its sequential numbering, was a continuation of the 'Rūznāmah-i Dawlat-i 'Alīyah-i Īrān' and effectively a continuation of the 'Rūznāmah-i Vaqāyī'-i Ittifaqīyah'. The first issue of this new series was numbered 593, published on 3 Jumādā al-Ūlā 1283 AH, while the last issue, numbered 650, was published on 10 Dhū al-Ḥijjah 1287 AH...

Rūznāmah- 'i 'Ilmīyah- 'i Dawlat-i 'Alīyah- 'i Īrān was the first trilingual publication—

in Persian, Arabic, and French—and Iran's first scientific journal. Its inaugural issue was printed and distributed on Monday, 27 Dīmāh, corresponding to the year 785 of the incomplete Jalālī calendar, equivalent to the first of Sha' bān al-Mu' azzam 1280 AH, at the government factory in Dār al-Khilāfah Tehran. The first issue included an explanation about Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh delegating the newspaper's affairs to I' tizād al-Saltānah, indicating that I' tizād al-Saltānah was responsible for the newspaper's management, whilst the late Mīrzā Muḥammad Ḥusayn Furūghī authored its content. The French-language sections were written by Monsieur Richard...

The newspaper "Iran" was published on 11 Muḥarram 1288 AH, one month after Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh Qājār ordered the closure of all monthly court-affiliated newspapers. The administration of newspapers, previously under 'Alī Qulī I'tiḏād al-Saltānah, was transferred by royal decree to

Muḥammad Ḥasan Khān l'timād al-Salṭānah (Ṣanī' al-Dawlah). The newspapers 'Ilmiyah-i Dawlat-i 'Alīyah, Dawlat-i 'Alīyah-i Īrān, Millatī, and Millat-i Sanīyah-i Īrān were shut down, and "Iran" was published in their stead.

The newspaper lacked specific details about its staff. However, based on most sources noting Muḥammad Ḥasan Khān's signature on many of the newspaper's announcements, he is considered its publisher and manager. Ṣadr Hāshimī, in the first volume of "Tārīkh-i jarāyid va majallāt-i Īrān", lists the newspaper's staff as Mīrzā 'Alī Khān Nā'inī and Muḥammad Ḥusayn Adīb (Dhakā' al-Mulk) as writers, Mīrzā Abū Turāb as the special illustrator, Mīrzā Sayyid Aḥmad as the newspaper's scribe, Ḥabīb Allāh as the special printing master, Mullā Ghulām Ḥusayn as the gilder, and Ustād Muḥammad Ḥusayn as the newspaper's bookbinder. Dr Nāshir al-Dīn Parvīn, in his book "Rūznāmah va rūznāmah-nigāri-i Īrāniyān va diḡar Pārsī'nivīsān", identifies Nā'inī as the newspaper's editor-in-chief...

From issue 16 (28 Sha'bān 1323 AH), the Rūznāmah-i Īrān-i Sulṭānī once again changed its title to "Iran". The reason for this change was the dismissal of Nadīm Bāshī from the newspaper's management and the reappointment of Muḥammad Bāqir Khān l'timād al-Salṭānah as the manager. l'timād al-Salṭānah then published 11 issues under the title "Iran" in continuation of the sequential numbering of the Rūznāmah-i Īrān-i Sulṭānī. In this translation, I've ensured the use of proper romanisation for Persian names and terms, such as 'Rūznāmah-i Īrān-i Sulṭānī' and 'l'timād al-Salṭānah', following the guidelines provided. The date has been presented in the format used in the original text, with the addition of 'AH' to denote the Islamic calendar...

The Rūznāmah-i Īrān was published from 1288 AH to 1313 AH under the management of Muḥammad Ḥasan Khān l'timād al-Salṭānah. After his death, the newspaper's management was transferred to his nephew, Muḥammad Bāqir Khān l'timād al-Salṭānah, who continued its publication from 1313 AH to the end of 1320 AH, and then from 28 Sha'bān 1323 AH. During the interval between 1321 AH and late Sha'bān 1323 AH, the newspaper's management was handed over to Mīrzā Muḥammad

Nadīm Bāshī. He assumed management of the Iran newspaper in late 1320 AH and published the first issue of the publication under the title “Rūznāmah-i Īrān-i Sultānī” (Saturday, 1st Muḥarram 1321 AH / 31 March 1903 CE)...

During the First World War, Rūznāmah-i Kāvah was published by a political group called "National Defense Committee" to strengthen nationalist, anti-Russian and pro-German sentiments among Iranians under the guise of archaism. One of the reasons why Taqī'zādah chose "Dirafsh-i Kāvīānī" as the emblem of his publication was that he believed that Dirafsh-i Kāvīānī should be the national emblem of Iranians instead of the lion and sun emblem. Because he claimed that Dirafsh-i Kāvīānī, unlike Lion and Sun, dates back to before Islam...

Şūr-i Isrāfil newspaper was founded in Tihṙān under the directorship of Mīrzā Jahāngīr Khān Shīrāzī and Mīrzā Qāsim Khān Tabrīzī, and it was published in the year 1325 Hijrī Qamarī. The first issue of Şūr-i Isrāfil, comprising eight pages in the "wazīrī" format with metal-type printing at the (Pārsiyān) press, was released on Thursday, 17 Rabī' al-Ākhir 1325 Hijrī Qamarī, corresponding to 14 Dey 1276 Yazdigardī Pārsī and 30 May 1907. Publication remained at the discretion of the management, whether to print or not. Şūr-i Isrāfil newspaper is one of the important papers established at the dawn of Iran's Mashrūṭiyat (Constitutional Revolution), which, through its critical platform and approach, made a significant contribution to the awakening and freedom of Iranians. Published weekly, Şūr-i Isrāfil was a political, historical, and ethical newspaper, and most of its editorials concerned political affairs and strongly criticised [more...]

The newspaper 'Tajaddod' was established in the city of Tabriz under the management of Sheikh Mohammad Khiabani, and its first issue was published in Jumada al-Akhir of the lunar year 1335. Despite extensive efforts, the author has not yet succeeded in finding even a single copy of this newspaper. However, what is certain is that the 'Tajaddod' newspaper was published weekly in Tabriz from the aforementioned year until the time of Sheikh Mohammad Khiabani's assassination, and it was one of Iran's good and useful newspapers. The story of the establishment of this newspaper by Khiabani is as follows: After Khiabani and his colleagues succeeded in forming a provincial conference with 480 representatives from the city of Tabriz and the provinces of Azerbaijan, a committee called the Provincial Committee was elected...

According to a special notice in the first issue of the first year, the newspaper was published once a week for the first two months and subsequently twice a week. The newspaper's office initially resided at the Khurshīd press, moved to the Majlis press from issue number 7 onwards, then relocated to Lālah-zār Street, and in the fourth year, it was moved to Nāširīyah Street...

Taraqqi, Rūznāmah-i (Qājār) – 1325 H.Q. (5 Issues)

The publication 'Taraqqi' was the title of two political and social periodicals during the Qajar and Pahlavi eras. This publication was first printed weekly during the Constitutional era by Mīrzā Muḥammad 'Alī Khān Tīhrānī. The second version was published by Luṭf Allāh Taraqqi in the 1920s. 'Taraqqi', under the management and authorship of Mīrzā Muḥammad 'Alī Khān Tīhrānī, known as 'Islāmbūli', began publication in Tehran on 17 Ṣafar 1325, 1 April 1907. This periodical was published in 4 pages, with two issues per week. The editor's name appeared at the end of some issues of 'Taraqqi'. The printing of this publication was lithographic and took place at the Imperial Press under the management of 'Abd Allāh Qājār...

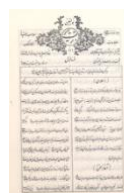

One of the most beneficial newspapers, which was published for a full nine years with literary and historical articles, is the Tarbiyat newspaper. This newspaper, established in Tehran under the ownership and management of "Zakā' al-Mulk", has consistently been the focus of scholars' attention due to its inclusion of useful and beneficial articles. The first issue of Tarbiyat newspaper was published on Thursday, 11th of Rajab 1314 AH, corresponding to 17th December 1896 CE. As was customary for pre-constitutional newspapers, the phrase "Bā ijāzah-i Vizārat-i Jalīlah-i Inṭibā'āt" was printed in the corner of the newspaper's masthead, and above the newspaper's name, the phrase "Huva al-Mu'īn" was inscribed. Tarbiyat, the first non-governmental newspaper in Iran, was published in Tehran from Thursday, 11th Rajab 1314 AH (1275 Solar Hijri) until

Thursday, 29th Muḥarram 1325 AH (29th Mihr 1286 Solar Hijrī)...

Until now, it was believed that a publication titled “Urdū-yi Humāyūn” was issued during the Nāṣirī era. However, two publications with this name were actually printed and distributed during that period. The first publication, “Rūznāmah-i Urdū-yi Humāyūn”, was issued during Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh’s first journey to Khurāsān, which took place in late 1283 and early 1284 AH. The second publication with this name, which doesn’t have the prefix “Rūznāmah” and is simply called “Urdū-yi Humāyūn”, was printed and distributed during Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh’s second journey to Khurāsān in 1300 AH, of which copies are still available. Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh published three of his numerous travelogues in the form of newspapers (although they are not actually newspapers, most sources have referred to them as such)...

The first issue of this newspaper was published on Friday, 5th Rabī‘ al-Thānī 1267 AH, with the phrase 'Yā Asad Allāh al-Ghālib' and the lion and sun emblem inscribed on its masthead. On either side, two suns were drawn, and in the middle of the page, 'Rūznāmchah-i Akhbār-i Dār al-Khilāfah' was written, beneath which an autograph of Nāṣir al-Dīn Shāh was printed...
